Student Satisfaction survey on Teaching Learning Process of Sikkim Government College Rhenock reflected that 40% of the student were found excellent, 32 % found very good, 23 % found good regarding sequence of the course. Likewise, 41% students were found excellent, 28% found very good regarding relevance of the unit in the syllabus. 32% and 40% student found excellent in the availability of the reference book and reading materials in the library. Regarding internal evaluation process majority of the student found internal evaluation process is fair enough and transparent for them i.e., 55 % student found excellent and 31 % were found very good. Related to external evaluation processes of the institution 56% student were found excellent and 34 % found it very good. In the LAB based course of the institution 36% student found excellent, 31 % found very well, 17% were found good and only 5% student found very poor condition of the LAB based course. 36% student were found excellent, 37% found very good, 10% student found good and 17% student found average for the management of extracurricular activities in the institution. Students agree and found it excellent that institution facilitate them to participate in extracurricular activities and helps them to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills among students. Despite low use of ICT, Smart class and LCD projector in the classroom, 96% of the students were satisfied that institution is fully committed towards the qualitative development and constantly focusing on the improvement of teaching learning processes. Students find overall teaching learning process within the institution good supportive and useful for the overall qualitative development.
