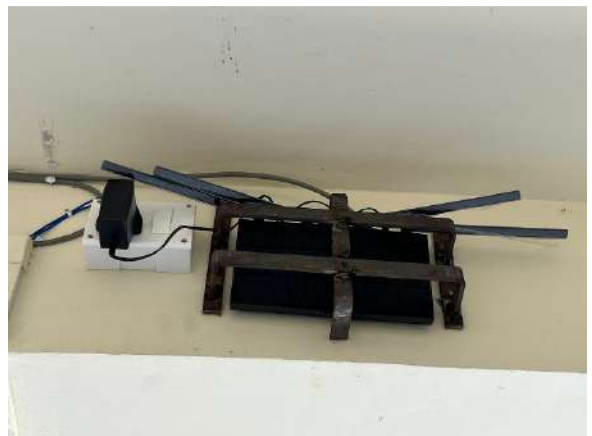

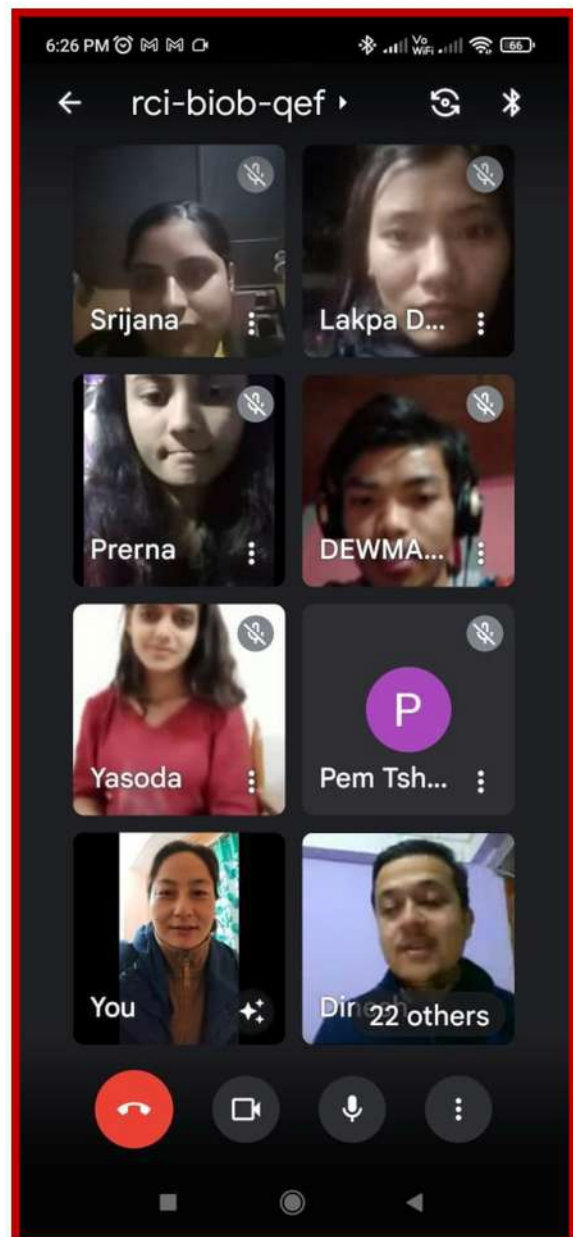
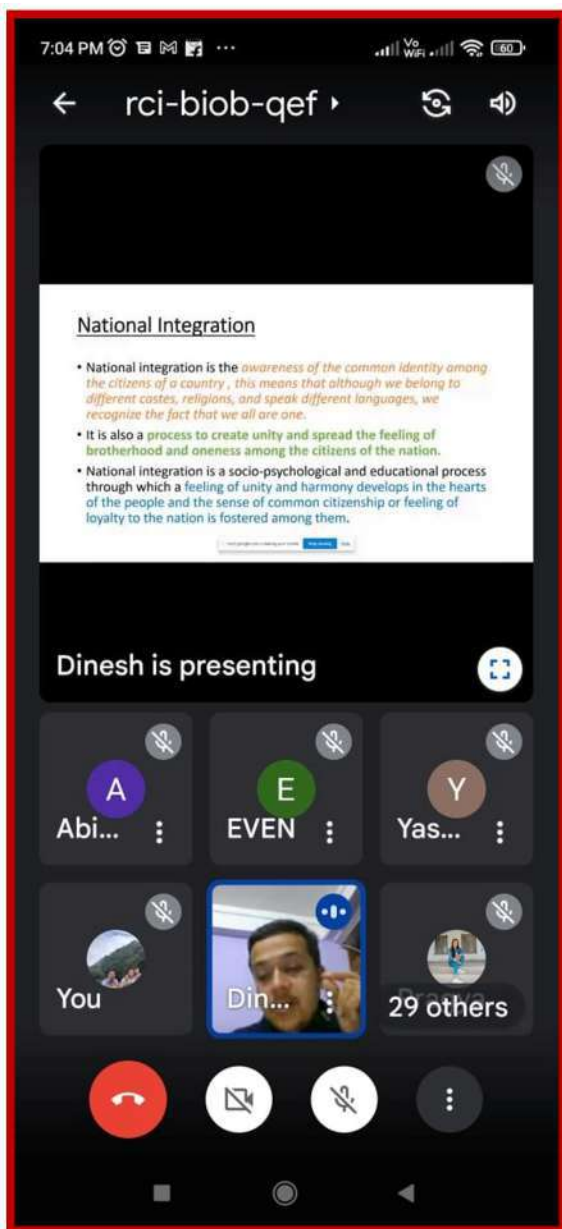


1ST SEMESTER ONLINE LECTURE SERIES ON THE THEME OF NATIONALISM AND NATIONAL INTEGRATION

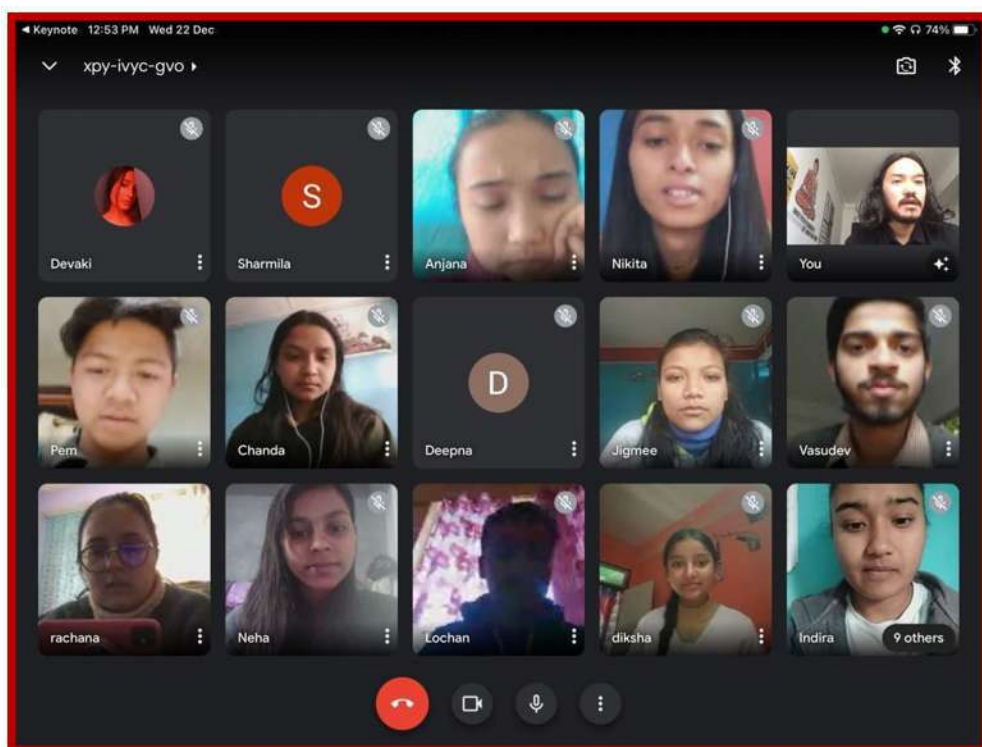


ORIENTATION PROGRAM ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT
