## **INSTITUTIONAL DISTINCTIVENESS**

In the year 2018-19, different departments of the College emphasized on taking its students to various places under the theme excursions and study trip. This practice proved beneficial for the students as they were able to visit many historical landmarks which they had only read in bocks before. Further, the students got to develop basic skills like interacting with fellow classmates, teachers and people from different walks of life whom they met during the visit. They were culturally, spiritually and emotionally enlightened during the field trip which spanned for a single day for some departments and lasted for a week for some. Department of geography to their students to New Digha and Talasari. Similarly, department of history to their students to Cooch Behar palace. The department of Economics, organised an Educational Exposure Tour for Honours' students of IV and VI semesters to Guwahati.

The students shared their experiences from their study tours which were as follows:

- Further their knowledge about geographical variations of various places was also accentuated.

In the year 2019-2020, the College took initiative to help aspiring entrepreneurs from the institution themed Entrepreneurship Development Program. Four Week and Six Week course on Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP) and Technological Entrepreneurship Development Program (TEDP) was organised in the college from 24<sup>th</sup> October to 30<sup>th</sup> of November, 2019.

The principal objective behind the program being, imparting and enhancing knowledge of students in the field of entrepreneurship, to upgrade their understanding of the Self-reliant and Sustainable business ventures. It is known to all that foremost priority of Education currently lies in making individuals independent, self- motivated and self-reliant. A child might be brimming with potential which they may harness in their field of interest if given a chance but they need to have a clear understanding of what exactly needs to be done. Working as an employee might not always give them the same degree of satisfaction when compared to a self-established business. So inculcating awareness about the scope of becoming an entrepreneur definitely helps an individual to fulfil their desire of satiating their thirst towards becoming a successful employer. 50 students from Fifth Semester undertook the course, with 25 B.Sc. students for EDP and 25 BA students for TEDP.

The Gender Sensitization Unit and Sexual Harassment Cell of the college organized frequent awareness programs in the institution. To inculcate the essence of Gender equity among the members of the institution, the Cell organized panel discussions, webinar on women issues, sensitization programme and observed International Women's Day like before. Also waste management in the institution was given priority by fortifying vermic compost pit. All the waste of the college got dumped in the pit, turn the waste into vermi compost manure which then got utilized for the garden within the campus. These helped the students to learn about the idea of recycle and sustainability. Due to the proximity of lush green environment all around, the institution takes pride in working towards creating a culture of protection of our ecosystem.

In the year 2021-22, the College focused more towards Social outreach programmes for students with an aim to help, uplift, and support those students who are deprived of certain services and rights. It involved learning, social planning, health support, and other projects for their welfare. Hence, through higher education institutions, these opportunities help the students to build a sense of responsibility and sensitivity towards the society. More importantly, students can deepen their understanding of individual leadership, systemic change and social responsibility in the context of a local, national and global multi-cultural society.

College put thrust on Internship Programme which helped students in testing out the practical aspects of what they know and focus on how to do a particular job. They may get to discover new things, familiarize themselves with the environment, follow the processes, and explore the career path that they have chosen to study for. Our institution also initiated numerous Internship Programmes to facilitate the students in their career building.
