Understand and adhere to professional, ethical, legal, security, and social responsibilities, ensuring ethical conduct and integrity in all endeavours.

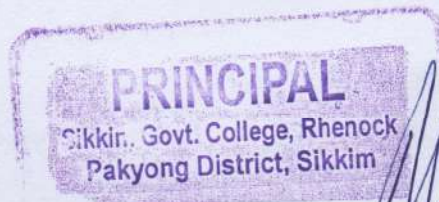
Function effectively both individually and as team members, honing their collaborative skills and fostering teamwork.
